This unique dual degree program offers you a valuable opportunity to earn both a Bachelor of Science (BS) degree from Kansas State University, and a Bachelor of Science degree in nursing (BSN) from Wichita State University. Both programs are conveniently located on the K-State campus in Manhattan, KS.

Key Program Features

- A degree from K-State will accelerate your nursing career toward your specialty area of interest and allow you to have twice the impact on patient care. For example, if you're interested in mental health, pairing your BSN with a degree in psychology can provide valuable insights into treating patients with mental illness, while a degree in human development and family science will prepare you to work with patients across the lifespan.
- ◆ Earn two degrees in approximately five years.
- Students develop their nursing skills in our state-of-the-art simulation laboratories and diverse clinical rotations.
- With small class sizes, students are personally mentored by faculty members who are experts in their field.
- Graduates from the BSN program are eligible to take the national RN licensing exam to become registered nurses. Graduates who pass the RN licensing exam will qualify for entry-level nursing positions in all healthcare settings.
- The BSN degree prepares students for graduate-level study.
