This course covered the topics of how to handle missing data, using non-normal data, identifying outliers, parceling, ANOVA using SEM, multiple sample path analyses, multiple sample CFA, latent mean differences, longitudinal models, power analyses, dyadic growth curves, latent class analyses, latent profile analyses, and growth mixture modeling.
