

## **Program Outcomes**

### **Marriage and Family Therapy - MS**

**Program Outcome 1:** The K-State MFT master's program will be recognized nationally as a strong program that provides the academic, clinical and professional training necessary for graduates to be successful clinicians in a variety of mental health settings and to provide a solid foundation for further doctoral education. This national reputation will include attracting highly qualified and diverse students as evidenced by:

- 1.1** At least 75% of admitted students will have an undergraduate GPA of 3.5 or higher
- 1.2** The average GRE of admitted students will be 300 or higher.
- 1.3** At least 50% of admitted students will come from outside Kansas.
- 1.4** At least 50% of offers to students will be accepted.
- 1.5** At least 33% of admitted students will come from diverse populations (e.g., race/ethnicity, international status, gender, sexual orientation, military status).

**Program Outcome 2:** K-State MFT master's students will make timely progress towards graduation.

- 2.1** At least 75% of admitted students will graduate within three years of entering the program.
- 2.2** At least 75% of admitted students from diverse populations will graduate within three years of entering the program.

**Program Outcome 3:** K-State MFT master's graduates will be prepared to take the licensing exam.

- 3.1** At least 80% of master's graduates taking the American Marital and Family Therapy Regulatory Board (AMFTRB) National Exam or equivalent state exam will pass the exam.
- 3.2** At least 80% of master's graduates from diverse populations taking the American Marital and Family Therapy Regulatory Board (AMFTRB) National Exam or equivalent state exam will pass the exam.

**Program Outcome 4:** K-State MFT master's graduates will be prepared to secure employment consistent with their career goals.

- 4.1** There will be 100% job placement within 12 months of graduation for those students who seek employment.

**Program Outcome 5:** K-State Family Center clients will find the clinical services they receive to be provided in a safe environment that honors diverse backgrounds and experiences while assisting them in reaching their goals.

- 5.1** Clients will average a score of "3" (Agree) on questions related to their satisfaction with their therapist.
- 5.2** Clients will average a score of "3" (Agree) on questions related to their satisfaction with their experience at the Family Center.
