Competitive Events:

1. **STAR Event Registration: done by each chapter in the National FCCLA Portal.**
2. *Registration Deadline:* STAR Events, Online Events:
 - a. [Registration & Rates | FCCLA \(fcclainc.org\)](https://fcclainc.org)
 - b. **May 7, \$55/person** (late fees \$100/\$200)
 - c. **You** register and pay for all STAR Events!
 - d. If qualify, but not competing at Nationals, contact Shandi Andres by **April 23** to notify alternates..
3. National Qualifiers: top two entries in each category of each event are qualified to represent Kansas at Nationals **if the State score is 85 or higher.**
4. For 2025, as a pilot, Kansas is able to send the top three entries in each event and level (if the score is 85 or higher) for the following events:
 - a. Job Interview
 - b. Leadership
 - c. Say YES to FCS Education
 - d. Sustainability Challenge
 - e. Teach or Train
5. Culinary Arts & Baking & Pastry events: top 3 in each with an 85 or above
6. STAR Event Registration fee: paid with funds from the Kansas FCCLA Educational Foundation for all **top gold** winners.
 - a. **You Pay Nationals for the STAR Event fees.**
 - b. **Kansas FCCLA will credit chapters on the State registration form for the registration fee for the top gold winners only.**
7. Registration packets: chapter adviser pickup
8. STAR Event Participant Orientation online - information emailed from Nationals
9. Room Consultants and Evaluators: both adults and students needed
 - a. We are required to have 1 for every 3 participants.
 - b. Volunteer when you register.
 - c. STAR Event Lead/Assistant Leads Needed - Kansas has been assigned to Repurpose and Redesign event.
 - d. All STAR Event Volunteers will meet on day of assigned event from 7:30-8:30 am.
10. New this year, Kansas has been assigned a STAR Event to be responsible for securing the room consultants for. Be sure to sign up in the portal and reach out to Shandi.

NLC Registration:

1. **ALL PERSONS:** who attend with the Kansas delegation in NLC hotels must register and pay the **required State and National registration fees.**

- a. National registration is on the Portal
- b. State registration is on the State registration and summary Form
- 2. All conference functions will require a name tag.
- 3. Each FCCLA member must have an adult supervisor that they report to.
 - a. State Officers, Peer Education members and District Presidents are the **responsibility of their local chapters** and will room with their chapters.

State Registration and Summary Form: Due May 16

- 1. Kansas Summary Form: List all attendees – parents, etc. Includes \$40 state registration fee.(includes t-shirt, 20 trading pins)
- 2. Kansas FCCLA bag is optional, order on form
- 3. **Sunday, July 6 Kansas Group Activity:** optional
 - Sea World from 4-9 pm
 - Ticket cost will be \$65 (originally \$75 – Foundation has contributed \$10/person)
 - Entry into the park at 4 pm
 - Dinner from 7:30-8:30 pm
 - Park closes at 9 pm
 - Dinner is an all you can eat buffet – grilled hamburgers and hotdogs, build your own salad, southern-style baked beans, corn and potato hash, condiments, warm fruit cobbler, coca-cola beverage or bottled water

Lodging: Chapters make own reservations

- h. Read information carefully
