amount needed PER CHILD

- 1 small banana
- 3/4 cup low-sugar breakfast cereal
- 1/2 cup lowfat fruit-flavored yogurt

Optional toppings:

- seedless grapes or berries
- raisins or other chopped, dried fruit

- crushed or tidbit pineapple
- granola-type cereal
