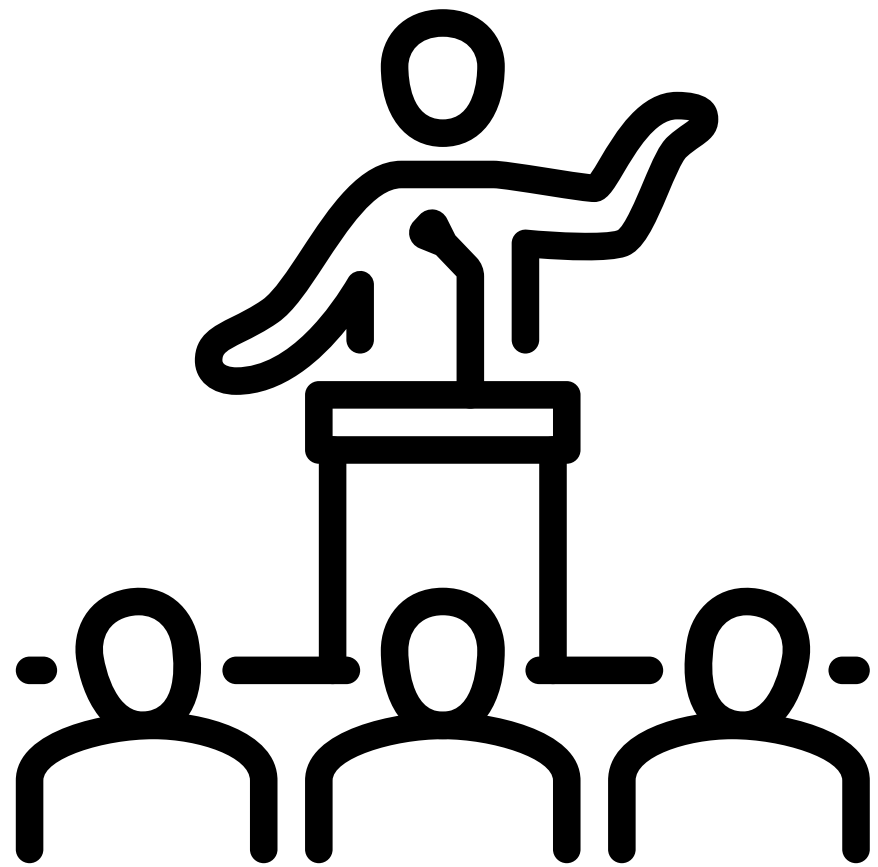
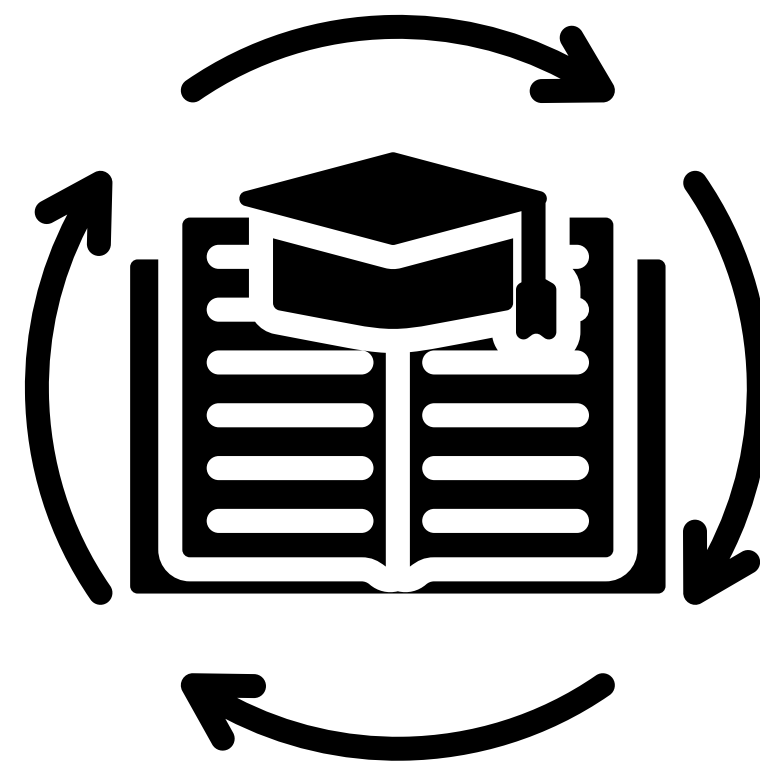

National Programs

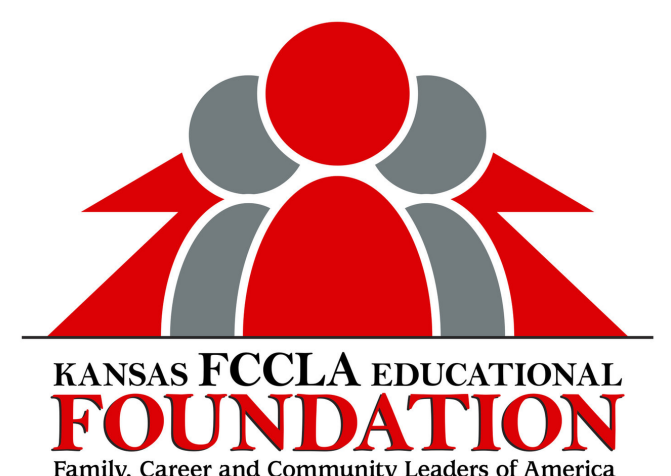
Get up to \$150 to support a chapter activity related to a National Program.

Post-Event report due February 20.

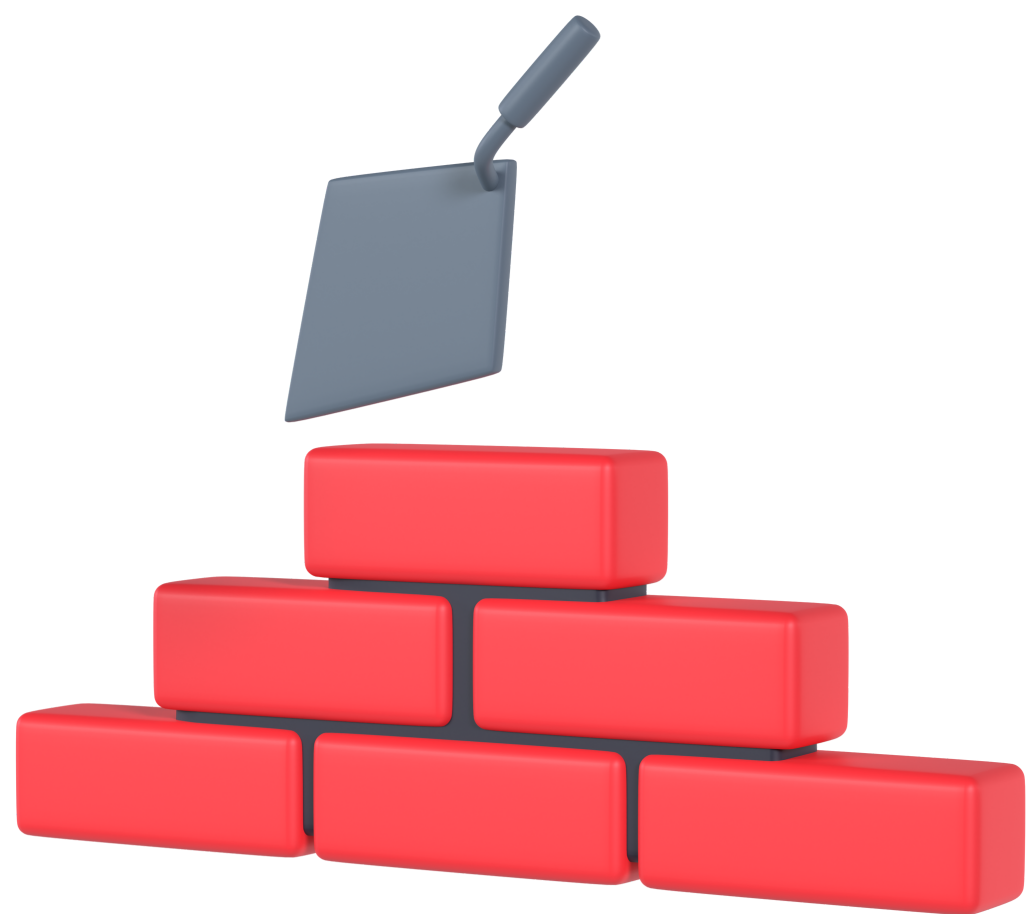


National Star Events

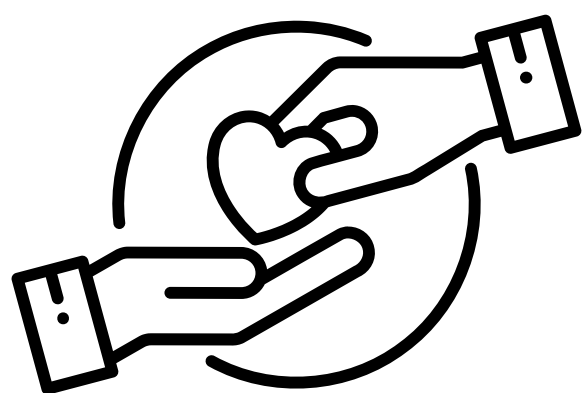
Foundation Event at Take Aim
