How to Calculate Time for Chapter & Community Rewards:

1. Track Each Member's Time

For every project, record:

- **Start time**
- **End time**
- **Total minutes** spent working

(Example: 3:00 PM–4:30 PM = 90 minutes)

2. Convert Minutes to Hours

Divide total minutes by **60**.

- 60 minutes = 1 hour
- 30 minutes = 0.5 hours
- 15 minutes = 0.25 hours

Example:

90 minutes ÷ 60 = 1.5 hours

3. Multiply Hours × Number of Members

For chapter totals, multiply the hours each project took by the number of participating members.

Example:

- 8 members worked 1.5 hours
- **8 × 1.5 = 12 total chapter hours**

4. Add All Project Hours Together

Once all project totals are calculated, add them up to determine your chapter's **combined community service hours**.
