Community Service, year specific

Administrator of the Year

Each year a statewide community service project is chosen by the incoming VP of Peer Education and State Executive Council. The flyer is posted. Award is based upon completion of the number of hours for the Community Service theme for the year.

Alumni & Associates Assistant for NLC

One administrator who is employed at a Kansas school with an FCCLA Chapter is chosen each year.

Business of the Year

All current Kansas Alumni & Associates members are eligible to apply for the position of assistant to the state advisor. This position has been created to provide the state advisor with assistance at State Leadership Conference, National Leadership Conference and Take AIM.

Community of the Year

One Kansas Business that has fostered the development of FCCLA is chosen each year.

District Chapter Adviser of the Year

One Kansas community that has fostered the development of FCCLA is chosen each year.

District Chapter Member of the Year

Will be presented to one adviser in each of the 12 districts of Kansas FCCLA each year. Up to 12 individual recipients will receive this award each year.

Family of the Year

Will be presented to one member in each of the 12 districts of Kansas FCCLA each year. Up to 12 individual recipients will receive this award each year.

Honorary Membership Form

One Kansas family that has fostered the development of FCCLA is chosen each year.

Kansas Adviser Mentor

Honorary Membership is to be granted to an individual who has helped to advance family and consumer sciences program(s) or has rendered outstanding service to FCCLA. Each chapter is eligible to submit the names of two qualified persons.

Kansas FCCLA Corporate Relations Liaison

For Chapter advisers who serve as a mentor to other chapter advisers.

Membership Recognition Award

Up to two (2) Corporate Relations Liaison(s) will be selected to aid in the process of establishing and working with partnerships and financial contributions from corporations in Kansas.

For chapters who increased their affiliated membership number. Submit affiliation numbers from current year and previous year to determine level of award. Also included on the application is the STAR Membership Award for the chapter with the highest level of members involved with STAR Events at the State Level.

Novice Adviser of the Year	Nominees must have been advising for 3 years or less to qualify. Nominate chapter advisers who have exceed expectations as a new adviser.
Parent/Guardian of the Year	One parent/guardian of a current FCCLA Member in the State of Kansas FCCLA is chosen each year.
Rush Week	Complete activities to help recruit new members during the month of September. Share names of new affiliated members.
Statewide Chapter Adviser of the Year	Will be presented to one chapter adviser in Kansas FCCLA each year.
Statewide Chapter Member of the Year	Will be presented to one chapter member in Kansas FCCLA each year.
State Rising Star of the Year	Award for first year members. Chapter may nominate one individual.
State Rising Chapter of the Year	Newly affiliated or first year chapters may apply. One chapter will receive this award each year.

Alumni & Associates	Five, \$500 scholarships may be awarded. Must have been an active member for three semesters. HS Seniors and College Alumni may apply.
Kansas FCCLA Leadership Scholarship	Up to seven, \$500 scholarships may be awarded. Must have been an active member for three semesters. HS Seniors and College Alumni may apply. Funded from state chapter fees.
Kansas FCCLA Peer Education Scholarship	Up to two, \$200 scholarships may be awarded. Must have been an active member for three semesters.
Ryan Haxton FCCLA Leadership Scholarship	Ryan Haxton was an FCCLA member at Southeast of Saline High School. This scholarship is meant to continue his legacy of giving back to those who have found growth and belonging through active engagement in FCCLA.
Lynette Yevak FCCLA Memorial Scholarship	Lynette Yevak was a Family and Consumer Sciences teacher, FCCLA advisor and avid supporter of Career and Technical Education. A scholarship will be given to an FCCLA member who demonstrates financial need and exemplifies FCCLA's value of serving others.
