Applicants must have the desire to represent the School of Human Sciences in a positive light, and are expected to demonstrate leadership by participating in the many opportunities for both college and school events. It is not required that students have extensive knowledge about the school and academic programs. Formal training and attendance at monthly meetings will be required. Ambassadors are required to participate in at least 15 volunteer hours in the fall semester and 15 volunteer hours in the spring semester.

- Enrolled in a major, minor, and/or undergraduate certificate in the School of Human Sciences
- Full-time undergraduate student (12 hrs./semester minimum)
- Cumulative K-State GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Able to commit to a full academic year
- Selections based on completion of the application and interview process
