Courses to explore are ENGL100, ENGL200, COMM106, ECON110, ECON120, PSCYH110, SOCIO211, MATH100, History elective, Humanities elective, Science elective and unrestricted electives. It is important to remember this plan will most likely result in taking classes year round for 3 years.
