

# Supplemental P-EBT

Due to COVID-19,  
DCF is providing a

Pandemic EBT (P-EBT)  
payment of \$375 per  
eligible child.**

## WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

All school aged children who were eligible for free or reduced-price meals through the National School Lunch Program are eligible for a one-time Supplemental P-EBT benefit covering the summer months June, July and August 2021.

### Did Not Receive School P-EBT

In some cases, students did not receive school P-EBT even though they qualified for free or reduced-price meals because they attended school in person during the 2020-2021 school year. If you do not already have a Kansas Benefits Card, you will receive one in the mail with the Supplemental P-EBT benefits on it.

Benefits will be issued Oct. 12-21, 2021.

### Received School P-EBT

Children who received P-EBT benefits for the 2020-2021 school year will receive their supplemental P-EBT payment on the same Kansas Benefits Card where their P-EBT benefits were issued.

Benefits will be issued Oct. 26-Nov. 4, 2021.
