#### >Human Ecology Core Electives (18 hours)

Select courses to support professional goals in consultation with advisor.

At least 9 hours must be 300-level or higher.

#### >Supporting Courses (18 hours) \*

Select courses to support professional goals in consultation with advisor.

All courses must be 300-level or higher, and from areas other than the College of Health and Human Sciences.

\*Students seeking licensure in family and consumer sciences education must meet licensure standards as well as degree requirements. See Family and Consumer Sciences Education Licensure Requirements B.S. and the College of Education. Students seeking licensure in family and consumer sciences education may apply 1-4 hours of specified EDSEC courses as Human Ecology electives.

Each student must complete at least 30 K-State resident credits for degree consideration. from K-State. Every student must complete 20 of the last 30 hours of resident credit at K-State. A minimum of 45 hours must be at a course level of 300 or above.

Note: College of Health and Human Sciences requires a "C" or higher in "Professional Studies" courses, and the K-State 8 requirements must be met. Up to half of the credits required for a four-year degree may be completed at an accredited two-year college.

Maximum of 60 credits from a two-year institution.
