*Admission to the Interior Design program is selective and highly competitive. A complete application (including an official high school transcript, and collegiate transcripts, and official ACT or SAT test scores and application fee) must be submitted to the K-State Office of Admissions by February 1. Contact the K-State Office of Admissions for further details.*

Each student must complete at least 30 K-State resident credits to be considered for a degree from K-State. Furthermore, the student must complete 20 of the last 30 hours of resident credit at K-State. A minimum of 45 hours must be at a course level of 300 or above.

**125 Hours Required for Graduation**

**>Grades of “C” or higher are required**

**Note: The College of Health & Human Sciences requires a “C” or higher in “Professional Studies” courses, and the K-State 8 must be met.**

Up to half of the credits required for a four-year degree may be completed at an accredited two-year college.\*

**\* Maximum of 62 credits from a two-year institution can be applied to degree requirements.**
